Scheduling and Rider Reservation Hours:

WTS office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Rides are scheduled by 2 p.m. two business days before you want to ride. Example: If you need a ride on Monday, your reservation needs to be made by 2 p.m. on Thursday. When a wheelchair van will be needed, you must let the schedulers know so that accommodations can be made to assure that a wheelchair accessible van is available in your area. Most rural areas will have a rotating schedule of when the van will be in town and available for use.
